ORDER

New Delhi, the 7th June, 2018

S.O. (E) - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955) read with clauses 3 and 7 of the Sugar Price (Control) Order, 2018, the Central Government hereby directs that -

(a) no producer of sugar shall sell or agree to sell or otherwise dispose off or deliver or agree to deliver white sugar or refined sugar in the domestic market or remove white sugar or refined sugar from the godowns of the factory in which it is produced for sale in the domestic market, at a rate below rupees twenty-nine per kilogram till further orders;

(b) the powers exercisable by it for enforcing this Order shall also be exercisable by the State Government and Union Territory Administration.

2. This order shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
