
Subject: Representation of Indian Biscuits Manufacturers' Association (IBMA) -

MIEQ Order dated 28.09.2018 for 2018-19 sugar season.

2. The matter has been examined in the Department. It is clarified that supply of white/refined sugar by sugar mills against valid invalidation letter/ ARO under advanced authorization/ DFIA against export of biscuits and assorted confectionery products manufactured by members of IBMA is treated as deemed exports for the local supplier of such inputs and will be accordingly covered under MIEQ declared vide order dated 28.09.2018 for 2018-19 sugar season.
