#### <u>Order</u>

Whereas, DFPD vide letters of even number dated 06.06.2022 has issued combined Export Release Order for sugar mills for quantity of 8 LMT of sugar. As per para 4 of the said order, permission was granted to sugar mills to dispatch/lift a total quantity of 8 LMT of sugar for export within 30 days from the date of issuance of the order.

- 2. Though mills are trying to dispatch allotted quantity of sugar for export within stipulated time frame, but due to logistic issues and onset of rainy season, sugar mills in some regions are facing problems in timely lifting of sugar for export, therefore, it has been decided to extend the time line for lifting of sugar for export from sugar mills by 15 days i.e. till 20.06.2022 upto the extent of their ERO quantity allocated vide order dated 06.06.2022
- 3. All other guidelines of letter of even number dated 06.06.2022 will remain same.
