**Subject: Export quota to new sugar mills which have commenced crushing during current Sugar Season 2022-23- reg**

Madam/Sir,

In order to prevent the uncontrolled export of sugar & with a view to ensuring sufficient availability of sugar for domestic consumption at a reasonable price, the Government has decided to allow the export of sugar up to a reasonable limit w.e.f 01.11.2022 till 31.10.2023. Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT), Ministry of Commerce vide Notification No. 40/2015-20 dated 28.10.2022 has also amended export policy in respect of sugar.

2. Subsequently, DFPD vide letter of even number dated 05.11.2022 has allocated export quota of 60 LMT to sugar mills for sugar season 2022-23 w.e.f. 01.11.2022 along with the guidelines for the export of sugar.

3. As per clause (4) of the guidelines dated 05.11.2022, DFPD has decided to allot of Export quota to sugar mills that may commence crushing for the first time as well as sugar mills that were closed during the last three sugar seasons; following guidelines were issued:-

“The new sugar mills which may commence sugar production for the first time during sugar season 2022-23 or the mills which were closed in the previous three or more sugar season(s) but may restart in the sugar season 2022-23 or the mills whose names are not indicated in the Annexure vide DFPD letter of even number dated 05.11.2022 will be allocated export quota of 18.23% of their estimated sugar production in sugar season 2022-23 duly verified by respective Cane Commissioner.”

4. In this regard, recommendations received from the Cane Commissioner have been examined and accordingly export quantity of 11,671 MT has been allocated to 1 sugar mill as mentioned below:-

5. Further, custom authorities shall ensure that sugar will be exported by the sugar mill / exporters / domestic refineries on the basis of export quota allocated to sugar mill and on furnishing the instant order, agreement between the sugar mill or merchant exporters / refinery & factory invoice (having same Plant Name, Short Name and Name of the Sugar mill as mentioned above) indicating dispatch of sugar from these sugar mill to whom quota has been allocated.

6. All other conditions of the DFPD order dated 05.11.2022 remains the same.
