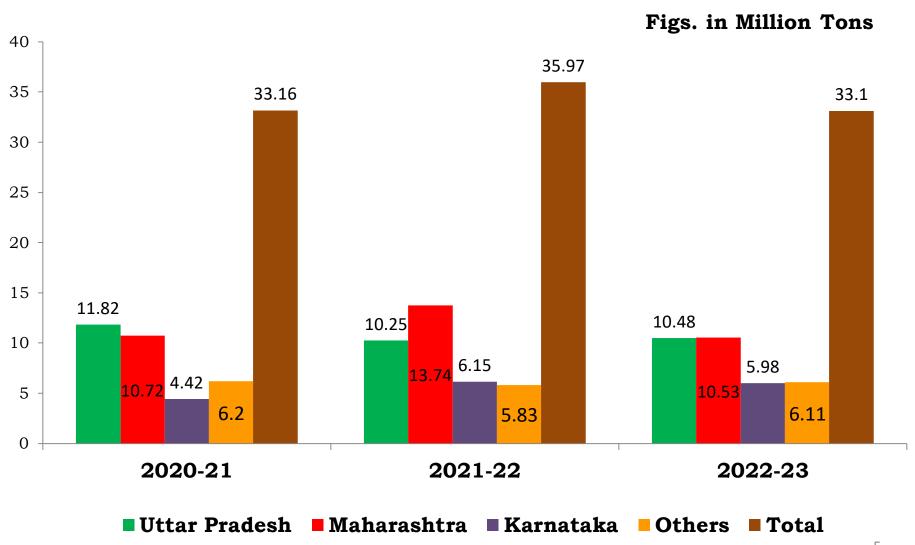


INDIA IS THE EPICENTRE OF THE WORLD SUGAR SWEETS

- India stands as the world's second-largest sugar producer, contributing over 18% of global sugar production.
- Additionally, India holds the position of the largest consumer of sugar, with a weightage of more than 16% in global sugar consumption.
- The absence of India in the international market results in a significant surge in sugar prices globally.
- Currently, Brazil is capitalizing on India's absence by achieving record sugar production & exports in the current season.

- India is strategically shifting focus towards diverting sugar into ethanol production rather than prioritizing exports.
- Till ethanol prices are more lucrative, India will absent from the world sugar market.
- This shift aligns with the Brazilian model, which prioritizes Ethanol production over sugar exports.
- In the hind sight sugar season (2022-23) would have been more profitable for sugar mills if the decision was made to export sugar instead of producing Ethanol..... Just a food for thought!!

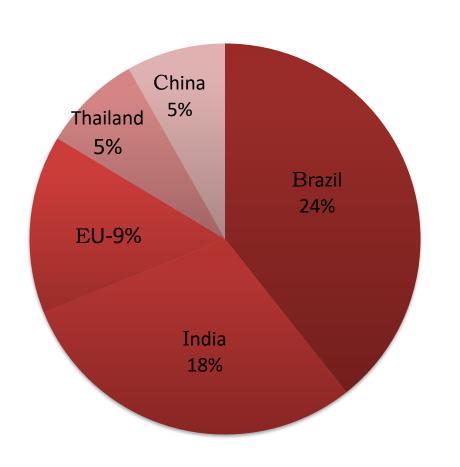

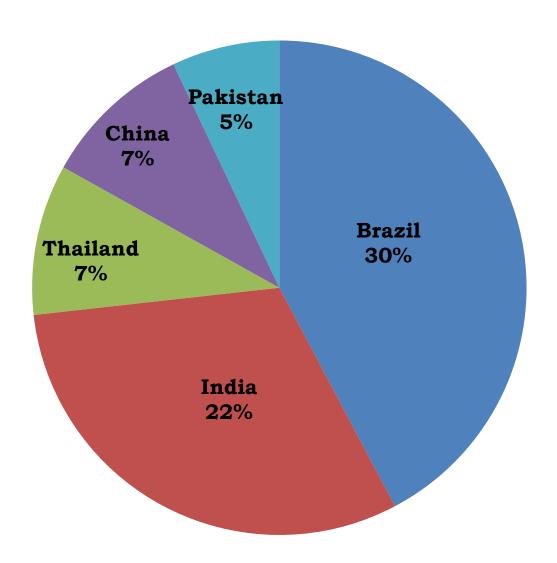

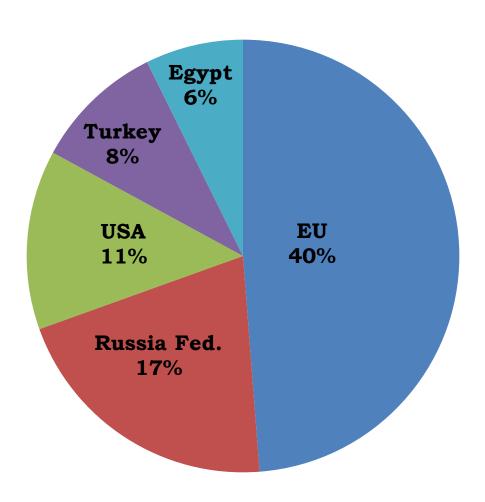

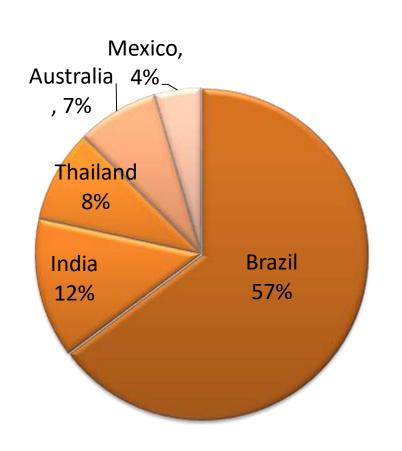

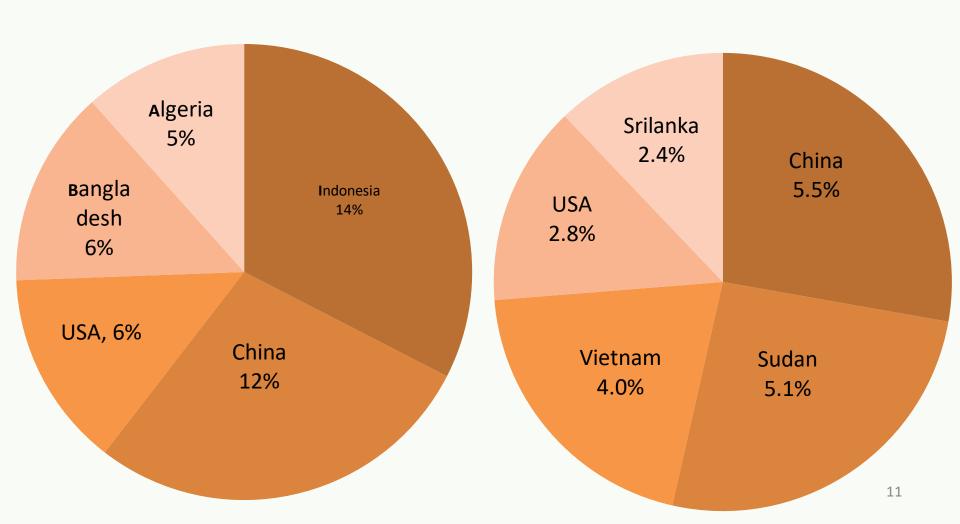

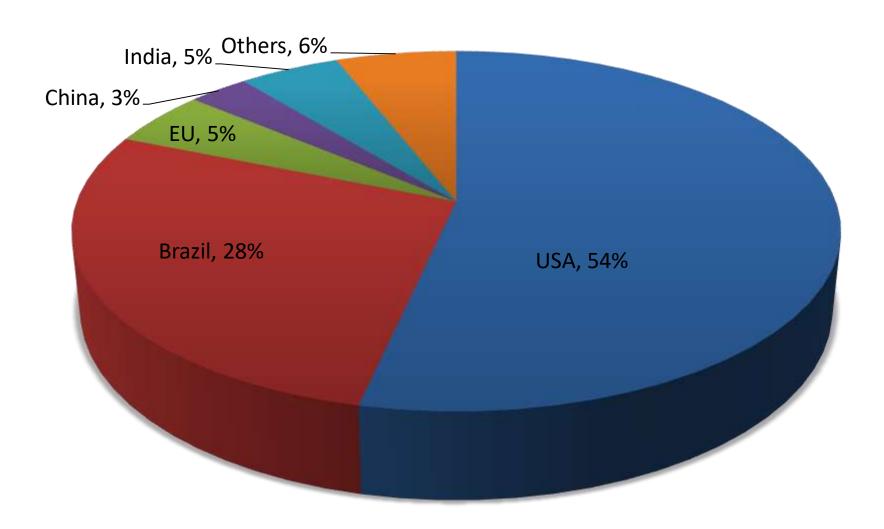

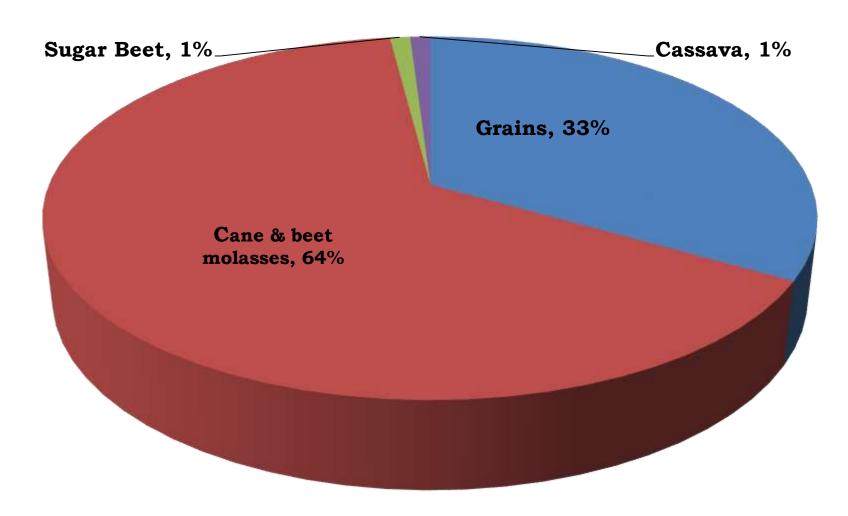

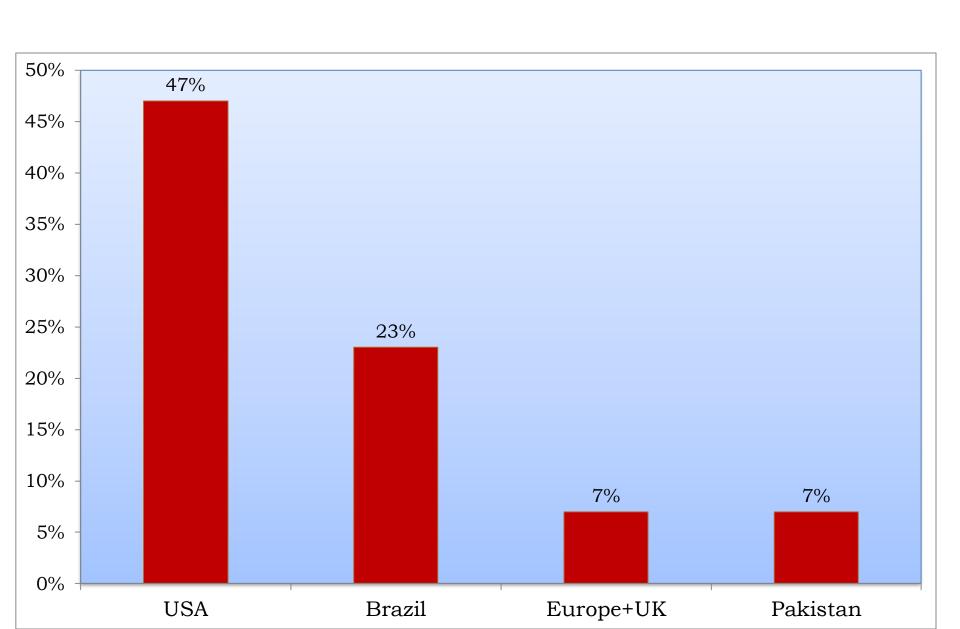
TOP 5 PRODUCERS OF ETHANOL



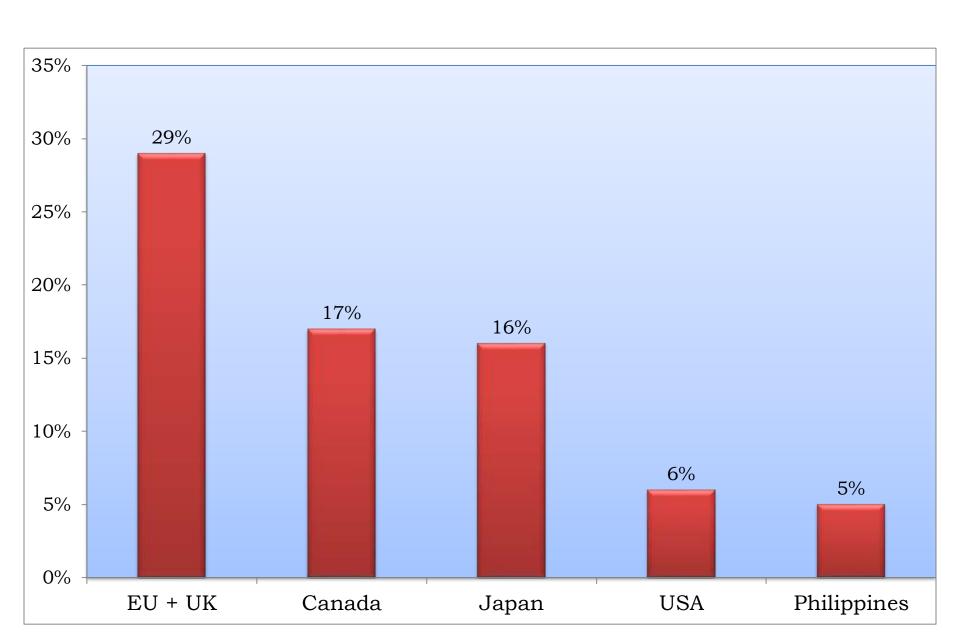
USE OF FEEDSTOCKS FOR PRODUCTION OF ETHANOL

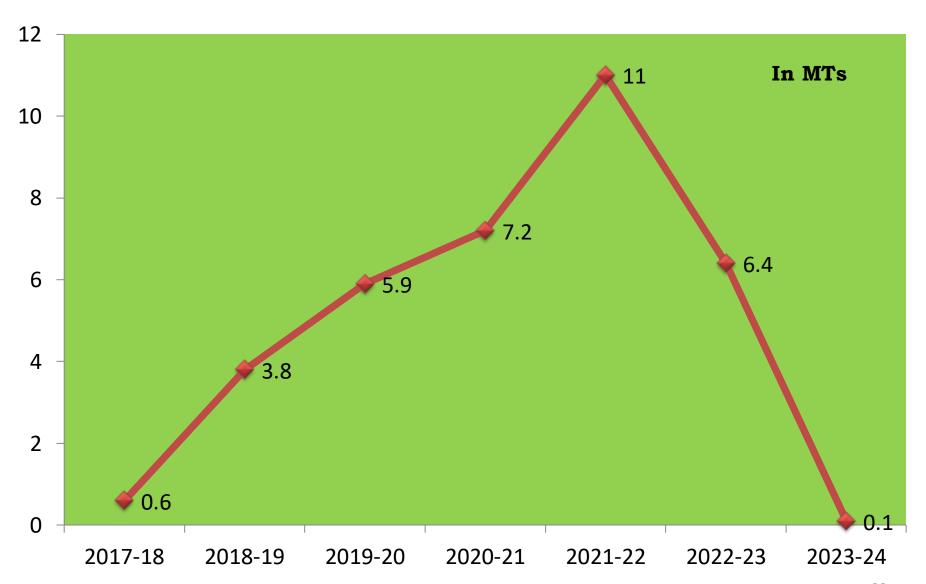

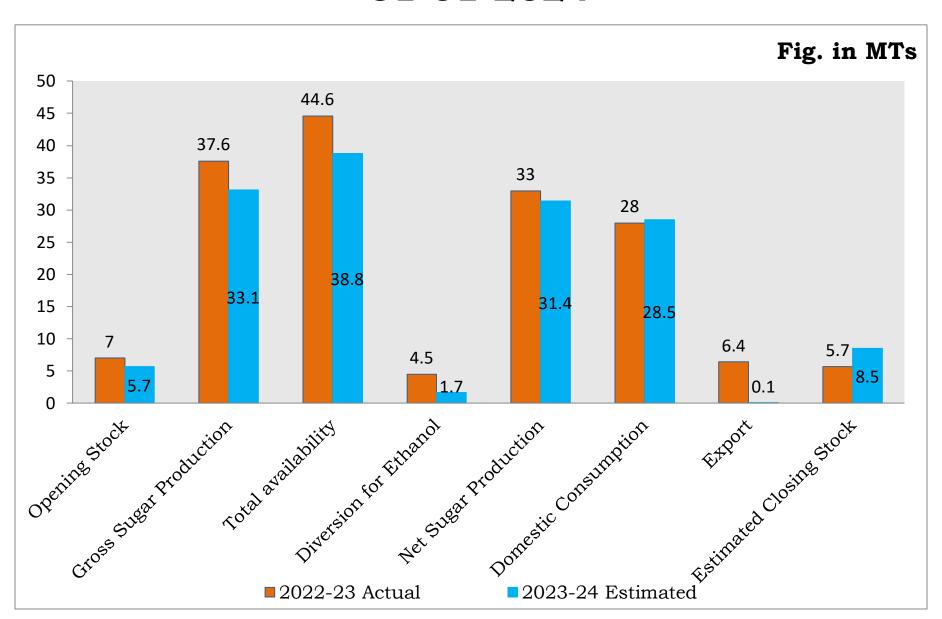
